- Requirements: Seeking a major in an engineering field (math and science related majors may be considered if they are deemed to be in the spirit of the scholarship)

- Include a copy of your SHS transcript
- Including a copy of your SAT, ACT or ASVAB results is encouraged
- Print only on standard white paper (no high-gloss or fancy colors)
- No special bindings other than staples or paper clips
- Remove or make illegible from all documents your social security number and date of birth if it appears on any of the included information
- Applications may be submitted in one of two ways
